New Jersey Assemblywoman Linda Stender, the passionate primary sponsor of the NJ GE food labeling bill, set the tone for cosponsor groups' educational tables, and keynote talks by NJ Food & Water Watch's Jim Walsh, and NOFA-NJ's Camille Miller.
