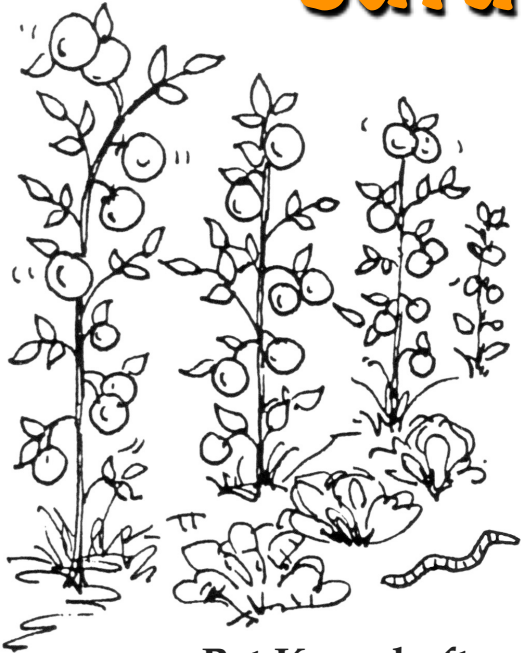

Pat Kenschaft says:

"I plan to leave at least one cold frame standing so you can see how I nurtured Chinese cabbage, lettuce, and parsley all (this!) winter. Also, I plan to harvest my last carrots from last April's sowing. This year's are under floating cover. Garlic thrived and is readying for a June harvest. Tomato plants will be out, each in its wall-of-water. Seeds sown this year include lettuce, Hukarai turnips, peas, corn, and beans. Will they all be up?"

2:00 - 4:00 PM

56 Gordonhurst Ave., Montclair: From Watchung and Grove, drive two blocks north on Grove and turn right on Gordonhurst. Third house on the right. Last tour at 3:30.

Judy Hinds says:

"LOTS will be up and growing in our seven 4'x4' squares: peas, onions, garlic, several varieties of lettuce, over-wintered kale plus perennial herbs and flowers. The newest big thing this year is a waist-high garden. I decided to add a VegTrug, which is now installed on the deck and planted in peas, carrots, chard, turnips, beets, arugula and more. All these seeds, even including the slow-minded carrots, should be up by then. C'mon by!"

2:00 - 5:00 PM

156 Rhoda Ave., Nutley: From Montclair, drive east on Watchung to the end. Turn left onto East Passaic. Take the second right onto Coeyman. After going under the high tension wires, take the next left onto Stanley, then the first left onto Rhoda. 156 is on the right with a big oak tree on the front lawn.
