The gardening season is far from over!

At Florence Rollino's you will see celery, cabbage, spinach, Brussels sprouts, covallo nero (Tuscan kale), bok choy, and collard greens in and out of cold frames. She is trying to have a twelve-month flowering garden, and you may see very tall cannas and drying limelight hydrangeas on the tree. From Montclair, take Bellevue Ave. east almost to ShopRite. Take the last left (Bellevue Terr.), and then the first left onto Wells Ct. Number 45 is the house at the end with solar panels.

At Alan Smith's take a self-guided front yard tour of a garden that includes a variety of greens.

Pat Kenschaft will feature Chinese Cabbage in a cold frame and winter carrots, soon to be covered with plastic bags of leaves for protection. There should also be bok choy, parsley, celery, garlic, onions, two types of kale, collards, and lettuce. Holly berries provide December color.

Environmental displays will be in the front yard of 56 Gordonhurst Ave.
