Kathy Sauerborn, 263 Chittenden Rd, Clifton, has an established garden of herbs and natives and now raises vegetables by reclaiming the lawn. From Montclair, go north on Grove St., take the first right after the cemetery; hers is the second house on the right.

Grace Grund, 3 Dodd St., Montclair, has a dozen egg-laying chickens. They eat all the organic scraps from home and from her restaurant "Terra," in the public library. Her summer vegetable garden is in a raised bed.

Sanchi Tripp, 8 Waterbury Rd., Montclair, has hens and two honeybee hives. Her seven raised garden beds grow all of the vegetables they eat in summer and much of what they eat in fall and winter.

Nick DiMinni, 11 Bruce Rd., Montclair, has a European inspired vegetable and herb garden including fig trees and a pergola covered with grape vines. Go 2 blocks north of Watchung on Valley.



Florence Rollino, 45 Wells Ct., Bloomfield, has a beautifully landscaped property, tucking vegetables in among other fascinating displays. From Montclair, go east on Bellevue Ave. almost to ShopRite. Left on Bellevue Terr., then 1st left onto Wells Ct.; 45 is the house at the end with solar panels.

Judy Hinds, 156 Rhoda Ave, Nutley, has a partly shady, partly square foot-type garden. From Montclair, go east on Watchung, cross over GSP, left on E. Passaic, 2nd right on Coeyman Ave., left on Stanley, left on Rhoda.

Lisa Rosen, 3 Chester Rd., Montclair, has two raised beds, 4' x 10' and 6' x 10'. She has been gardening for about ten years, and has implemented "square foot gardening" in the larger bed.

Alan Smith, 148 Forest St., Montclair, offers a self-guided front yard tour of a garden that includes a variety of greens.

Pat Kenschaft, 56 Gordonhurst Ave., Montclair, raises almost all her family's vegetables year round with no poisons, power machinery, or commercial fertilizers. 10:30 last tour; nobody allowed in the back yard after 11:00 AM. 🌸
