Paul has an intense front-yard organic permaculture garden. Judy and Necole have rain barrels. Florence has a beautiful landscaped-designed garden including many vegetables in her shaded back yard. Pat raises almost all her veggies with no poisons, commercial fertilizers or power machinery.

A potluck supper will follow the tour in the back yard of the home of Nancy Taiani, 50 Gordonhurst, after which the annual meeting of the Cornucopia Network of NJ will be held. All are welcome to both.
